

CHAPTER CCXLI.

AN ACT LEGALIZING CERTAIN ACTS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF OTTER TAIL, RELATING TO LEVYING EXTRA TAX FOR EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the action of the board of county commissioners of the county of Otter Tail, in levying a tax of one mill upon each dollar of the taxable property of said county, for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, for the purpose of raising a fund to build a court house in and for said county, is hereby declared legalized and made valid, the same as though the action of the said county commissioners in assessing and levying said tax had been in strict conformity to the statutes existing and in force at the time of such assessment and levy.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCXLII.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN ROADS IN THE COUNTY OF OTTER TAIL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Whereas, according to law certain defects appear regarding the laying out and surveying the county roads of the county of Otter Tail; therefore,

SECTION 1. That all county roads legally surveyed in and throughout the respective towns of the county of Otter Tail be legalized and made valid the same as if the law had been complied with in all respects by the town supervisors of their respective towns or by the board of county commissioners of said county of Otter Tail.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
