CHAPTER CCLXIII:

AN ACT TO PREVENT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CATTLE OR OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS IN THE COUNTIES OF MARSHALL AND KITTSON.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow any cattle, horses, mules, sheep or swine, owned by such person or persons, or of which such person or persons have control or may be in possession, to run at large upon any public highway, or upon the lands of any other person or persons in the counties of Marshall or Kittson, in this state, during any season of the year, unless they are carefully herded.

Sec. 2. Any person or persons who shall violate or neglect the provisions of the first section of this act shall be liable for all damages that may occur in consequence of the trespass of such

animal or animals.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCLXIV.

AN ACT TO PREVENT CATTLE AND OTHER ANIMALS FROM RUN-NING AT LARGE IN THE TOWN OF MARSHAN, COUNTY OF DAKOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow any cattle, horses, mules, asses, sheep, or swine owned by them or of which they may have possession or control, to run at large upon the public highways or upon the lands of any other person during any season of the year in the town of Marshan, county of Dakota.
