

CHAPTER CCLXXIX.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE CATCHING OF FISH IN LAKE MINNIE BELLE IN MEEKER COUNTY, IN ANY MANNER OTHER THAN WITH HOOK AND LINE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill or destroy any fish, in any manner other than with hook and line, in Lake Minnie Belle and adjacent inlets and outlets, in Meeker county, Minnesota.

SEC. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this act shall, upon conviction thereof before any justice of the peace of said county, be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than ten, and may be committed to the county jail until such fines and costs of prosecution are paid; such commitment, however, not to exceed the term of ten days.

SEC. 3. All proceedings under this act shall be commenced within thirty days from the time such offence was committed, and all fines imposed and collected under this act shall be paid into the treasury of said county for the use of the common schools of said county.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCLXXX.

AN ACT TO REGULATE FISHING IN LAKE MINNETONKA, COUNTY OF HENNEPIN, STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall hereafter catch, capture or destroy in any manner, except with hook and line, any fish within the waters of Lake Minnetonka, county of Hennepin, State of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. Whoever violates the provision of the preceding section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof
