

CHAPTER CCLXXXIII.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE CATCHING OF FISH IN THOMPSON LAKE IN WASECA COUNTY DURING CERTAIN SEASONS OF THE YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill or destroy any fish in any manner whatsoever in the lake commonly called Thompson Lake, in the town of New Richland in Waseca county, or in any inlet or outlet of said lake, between the fifteenth day of March and the fifteenth day of May in any year, and after said fifteenth day of May except only with hook and line or spear.

SEC. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCLXXXIV.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWN OF HONOLULU, IN STEVENS COUNTY, TO HODGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the town of Honolulu, in Stevens county be, and is hereby changed to that of Hodges.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
