CHAPTER CCLXXXIX.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWN OF MADISON, IN LYON COUNTY TO AMIRET.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the name of the town of Madison, in Lyon county, is hereby changed from Madison to Amiret.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage, Approved February 26, 1879.

CHAPTER CCXC.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWN SITE OF BRUNTON, IN MCLEOD COUNTY, TO THAT OF LAKE ADDIE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the said town site of Brunton, in the county of McLeod and state of Minnesota, is hereby changed to the name of Lake Addie.

SEC. 2. And that it shall hereafter be known and designated officially and otherwise, as Lake Addie.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
