

CHAPTER CCXCI.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE LUTHERAN AND REFORMED SAINT PAUL'S CHURCH ASSOCIATION OF NEW ULM, AND TO MAKE VALID THE ACTS THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of that certain religious corporation located in New Ulm, in the county of Brown, incorporated under the general laws of this state, under the name of "The Lutheran and Reformed St. Paul's Church Association of New Ulm," be and the same is hereby changed to "The Lutheran St. Paul's Church Association of New Ulm," in conformity with a resolution passed by the members of said church on the nineteenth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, and all acts heretofore done by said trustees in the name of "The Lutheran St. Paul's Church Association of New Ulm," are hereby declared as valid and effectual to all intents and for all purposes as if the same had been done in said incorporated name of "The Lutheran and Reformed St. Paul's Church Association of New Ulm." *Provided, however,* That this change shall not affect the rights or property of said corporation, save only that said corporation shall hereafter be known by said latter name, and in said name shall all the business thereof be transacted.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCXCII.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWN OF DARIEN IN STEVENS COUNTY TO THAT OF DARNEN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the town of Darien, in Stevens county, be and is hereby changed to the name of Darnen.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
