

CHAPTER CCXCVI.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWN OF MANOMIN IN ANOKA COUNTY TO THAT OF FRIDLEY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the town of Manomin, in the county of Anoka, state of Minnesota, is hereby changed to that of Fridley, by which it shall be designated for all purposes whatsoever.

SEC. 2. All records, plats, proceedings and documents of whatsoever nature which are now the property, and records of the said town of Manomin, are hereby declared to be, and for the purposes of this act are the records, plats, proceedings and documents of the town of Fridley, and all officers, moneys, credits and effects which are now of the town of Manomin, are hereby declared to be the officers, moneys, credits and effects of the town of Fridley.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCXCVII.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE MINNEAPOLIS FEMALE SEMINARY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the Minneapolis Female Seminary, an institution incorporated under the laws of the State of Minnesota, and located in the city of Minneapolis, in said State be, and the same is hereby changed to the "Bennet Female Seminary of Minneapolis," and that all property devisees, rights and privileges belonging or appertaining to said corporation under its present name, shall in like manner belong and appertain to said corporation under its name as provided by this act.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
