

CHAPTER CCXCVIII.

TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE TOWN OF OKACHUDA, IN MURRAY COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of the town of Okachuda, in the county of Murray, is hereby changed to that of Mason.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCXCIX.

AN ACT TO CONFIRM THE GRANT OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS TO THE MINNEAPOLIS STREET RAILWAY COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That whereas the city of Minneapolis did, by ordinance, entitled "An ordinance authorizing and regulating street railways in the city of Minneapolis," passed by the city council of said city on the ninth day of July, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and approved by the mayor of said city on the seventeenth day of July, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and by ordinance passed July third, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, and amended July eighth, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, and approved July tenth, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, grant to the Minneapolis street railway company the right to construct and maintain a street railway through the streets of said city, with certain rights and privileges in said ordinance particularly set forth; now the said right to construct and maintain said street railway through the streets of said city, with the rights and privileges as set forth and qualified in said ordinance, is hereby legalized and granted to said company.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
