

CHAPTER CCCVII.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE SALARY, COMPENSATION AND FEES OF
COUNTY OFFICERS OF GOODHUE COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The annual salary of the county auditor shall be as now fixed by law.

SEC. 2. The annual salary of county treasurer shall be two thousand dollars. The salary hereby fixed shall be in full, including clerk hire.

SEC. 3. The fees of the register of deeds shall be as now fixed by law; *Provided*, that all fees collected or received by him over and above two thousand and two hundred dollars in any one year, in performing the duties pertaining to his office, shall be paid over by him into the county treasury, taking the treasurer's receipt therefor; the same to be applied to the current expenses of the county.

SEC. 4. The compensation and fees of the clerk of the district court shall be as now fixed by law; *Provided*, that all fees or compensation received by him over and above fifteen hundred dollars in any one year, in performing the duties pertaining to his office, shall be paid by him into the county treasury, in the same manner, and to be applied to the same purposes, as prescribed in section three of this act.

SEC. 5. The fees of sheriff shall be as now fixed by law, except that he shall receive for board of prisoners confined in the county jail the sum of three dollars per week while so confined, and for sums collected on an execution where the sum exceed the sum five thousand dollars, on all amounts in excess of that sum, one per cent.

SEC. 6. The annual salary of the judge of probate shall be fifteen hundred dollars. All fees or compensation received by him over and above his specified salary, shall by him be paid into the county treasury, in the same manner and be applied to the purposes as prescribed in section three of this act.

SEC. 7. The annual salary of county attorney shall be seven hundred and fifty dollars, to be paid as now provided by law.

SEC. 8. The compensation of the county superintendent of schools, shall be fixed by the county commissioners, and paid in the same manner as the salary of other county officers.

SEC. 9. All acts and parts of acts fixing a different salary or compensation, or prescribing fees differing from the provisions of this act, for the same service specified in this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 10. That this act shall apply to the several officers named therein at the expiration of their present terms of office, except as to the price of board in the county jail, which shall take effect immediately as amended.

SEC. 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
