

CHAPTER CCCVIII.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE SALARIES OF COUNTY OFFICERS IN
MOWER COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The salary of the auditor of Mower county shall be fifteen hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 2. The salary of the treasurer of Mower county shall be fifteen hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 3. The register of deeds of Mower county shall be entitled to six cents per folio for recording and fifteen cents per description for abstracting, and twenty cents for his certificate thereto; *Provided*, that all excess of fees over and above eighteen hundred dollars per annum be returned to county treasury to credit of general fund.

SEC. 4. The fees of the sheriff of Mower county shall remain as now provided by law, except that he shall receive only three dollars per week for boarding prisoners in county jail.

SEC. 5. The fees of clerk of court for said county shall remain as now provided by law, except that he shall receive only one dollar for granting marriage license and recording same; *Provided*, that all excess of fees over and above one thousand dollars per annum be returned to the county treasury to credit of general fund.

SEC. 6. The salary of the superintendent of public instructions for said county shall be twelve hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 7. The county commissioners of said county, by majority vote of the entire board, are hereby authorized to vote clerk hire for the auditor of said county, not to exceed six hundred dollars per annum.

SEC. 8. This act shall take effect and be in force at the expiration of the terms of office of the several officers now holding the offices herein named.
