

CHAPTER CCCIX.

AN ACT REGULATE THE SALARY, FEES AND COMPENSATION OF
COUNTY OFFICERS IN THE COUNTY OF WINONA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The annual salary of each, the auditor and treasurer in the county of Winona, shall be two thousand five hundred dollars, including all clerk hire; *provided*, that the board of county commissioners of said county, by a majority vote of all the members of said board, may allow such additional compensation for clerk hire as in their opinion may be deemed advisable.

SEC. 2. The annual salary of the judge of probate in the county of Winona shall be one thousand dollars, including all clerk hire.

SEC. 3. The compensation of county superintendent of schools in the county of Winona shall be fixed by the county commissioners. *Provided*, That the same shall not exceed the sum of one thousand dollars.

SEC. 4. The fees of the sheriff in the county of Winona shall be as now provided by law, except that he shall receive for board of prisoners in the county jail the sum of three dollars per week when so confined; and ten cents per mile for all miles actually traveled in summoning grand and petit juries.

SEC. 5. The persons now holding the several offices specified in this act shall not be affected by the provisions of this act during the term of office, for which they were elected.

SEC. 6. All acts and parts of acts fixing different salaries or compensation, or prescribing fees differing from the provisions of this act for the same service specified in this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
