

## CHAPTER CCCXXXVII.

AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE OFFICE OF COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS IN DAKOTA COUNTY, AND MERGE THE DUTIES HERETOFORE PERFORMED BY SAID SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS WITH THAT OF PROBATE JUDGE OF SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the office of county superintendent of schools in the county of Dakota be and the same hereby is abolished, and that the judge of probate of county aforesaid is hereby authorized to perform the duties of superintendent of schools in and for said county as hereinatter provided.

SEC. 2. The judge of probate shall examine persons proposing to teach common schools in the county, in conformity to section seven of chapter four, of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, and shall receive as compensation for such examination the sum of one dollar for each teacher so examined, said sum to be paid by the person examined. Examination of teachers shall be held at such times and places in said county as designated by the judge of probate.

SEC. 3. Said judge of probate, while acting as superintendent of schools in county aforesaid, shall not be required to visit the schools in said county, nor shall he receive any compensation for visiting the schools in county aforesaid.

SEC. 4. Said judge of probate shall receive as compensation for all duties imposed upon him agreeable to the school law of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, the sum of one hundred dollars, to be paid in the same manner as the salaries of other county officers in said county.

SEC. 5. The provisions of this act shall take effect at the expiration of the term of office of the present superintendent of schools in county aforesaid.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
