## CHAPTER CCCXLL

AN ACT TO LIMIT THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER TO THE COUNTY WHEREIN SAID COURT IS ESTABLISHED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the municipal court of the city of Stillwater is hereby prohibited from sending any summons, process or writ outside of the boundaries of the county of Washington, and all summons, process or writ of said court outside of the county of Washington and the service thereof outside of said county is hereby declared to be absolutely null, void, and of no effect, and the jurisdiction of said municipal court outside of said Washington county is hereby abolished.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

## CHAPTER CCCXLII.

AN ACT TO LIMIT THE TIME OF HOLDING SESSIONS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN HOUSTON COUNTY, AND REGULATING THE FEES OF THE SAME.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The county commissioners of the county of Houston shall each receive three dollars per day for each day they are necessarily employed in transacting the county business of said county, and six cents per mile for every mile traveled in going and returning from the meeting of the county board of said county in the discharge of any official duty, to be computed by the nearest traveled route, but no county commissioner in said county shall receive pay for more than thirty-five days, or mileage for more than five sessions of said board for each year.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
