

CHAPTER LII.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FOURTEEN SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR, BEING AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF FERGUS FALLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter fourteen of the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, be amended by adding to said section two, at the end thereof the following, to wit: except Lincoln avenue, Bismarck avenue, and the streets lying between Summit avenue and Lake Alice.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER EIGHT OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY, ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF CALEDONIA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section five of chapter eight of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy, entitled an act to incorporate the village of Caledonia, be amended by adding thereto the following, to wit:

And said village of Caledonia shall pay to said township of Caledonia one-half of all lawful expenses in holding such general elections named in this section.

SEC. 2. That section six of chapter eight of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy aforesaid be amended by adding thereto the following, to wit:

Every chattel mortgage executed upon property within said village at the time of the execution thereof shall be filed with the
