

CHAPTER LXXV.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE UNION IMPROVEMENT AND ELEVATOR COMPANY OF THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA TO TRANSACT BUSINESS IN THE STATE. APPROVED MARCH SEVENTH, ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one, of chapter one hundred and twenty-three of the special laws of A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy, be, and the same is amended by adding to said section the following to-wit: That said corporation shall hereafter have full power and authority to hold its corporate meetings in this state and elect at its office in Duluth its board of directors, and elect or appoint in conformity to its by-laws, all officers and agents to all intents and purposes as though said corporation had been duly organized under the general laws of this state; and that it may erect and maintain elevators and transact all or any of the business authorized in this section, at any place or places, subject to the provisions of the general laws regulating said business.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXVI.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SEVEN OF CHAPTER THREE OF CHAPTER SIX OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE, RELATING TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CITY OF SHAKOPEE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That section seven of chapter three of chapter six of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, be amended by adding at the end thereof the following provision:

The mayor shall have power to remove the chief of police and by and with the consent of the common council to appoint a successor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
