

## CHAPTER VIII.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF LAMBERTON, COUNTY OF REDWOOD, STATE OF MINNESOTA, UNDER CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-NINE OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the following described territory, in the county of Redwood, and state of Minnesota, to wit:

The west half of section number twenty-three, town one hundred and nine, range thirty-seven, be and the same is hereby constituted the village of Lamberton, under the provisions of chapter one hundred and thirty-nine of the General Laws of the state of Minnesota, for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, and the amendments thereto.

SEC. 2. That J. S. Letford, Frank Schanderd and N. P. Nelson, are hereby designated commissioners to carry out the provisions of section nine of said chapter, and the secretary of state is hereby directed to issue his official notification of the passage of this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER IX.

AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF SHERBURNE, IN THE COUNTY OF MARTIN, UNDER THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the following described territory in the county of Martin, to wit: All of the west half and lots one and two, section seven, township one hundred and two, range thirty-two, be and the same is hereby incorporated as the village of Sherburne.
