CHAPTER LXXX.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-EIGHT OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section one of chapter one hundred and fiftyeight of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-

seven, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to use any seine or trap of any kind, except hook and line, or spear, in catching fish in the Zumbro river or any of its tributaries above Zumbro Falls in the county of Wabasha, and it shall be lawful for any person to fish in the waters of the Zumbro river below Zumbro falls in said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXI.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FOUR, OF CHAPTER TWENTY-SIX, OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO, AND SECTION FOUR, OF CHAPTER THIRTY, OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN. RELATING TO ELECTIONS IN FARMINGTON, DAKOTA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section four, of chapter twenty-six of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read "at all village elections held under this act, the polls shall be opened at nine o'clock in the forenoon and continue open until four o'clock of the same day."

Sec. 2. That section four, of chapter thirty, of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, be

amended by striking out the words "on that question."

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are

hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
