

CHAPTER LXXXII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION NUMBER SIXTEEN OF CHAPTER NUMBER SEVENTEEN, OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN, RELATING TO THE POWERS OF JUSTICES OF THE PEACE IN THE VILLAGE OF LE SUEUR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section sixteen of chapter seventeen of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven be, and the same is, amended by adding thereto the following: "and they shall also have and exercise the same powers, duties and jurisdiction as are conferred by the general laws of this state, on other justices of the peace."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THREE OF CHAPTER EIGHTEEN, RELATING TO THE HOLDING OF ELECTIONS IN THE VILLAGE OF MARINE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three of chapter eighteen of the special laws of A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, being an act entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Marine" be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word "December" in the second line of the printed copy of said section three, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "October," it being hereby intended to change the time of holding the annual election in said village of Marine, from the first Monday of December in each year to the first Monday of October in each year.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
