

them. The said hearing may be adjourned from time to time by the said commissioners until the same is completed.

The publication of said notice shall be sufficient service of such notice upon all persons interested, and it shall not be necessary to specify in said notice the names of any such persons.

The said commissioners are empowered to institute new or further proceedings aforesaid, for the condemnation of, land for said roads and approaches or any part thereof from time to time, as they shall deem necessary.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XCVIII.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE TITLE OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-THREE OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the title of chapter one hundred and fifty-three of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, which now reads:

"An act to authorize certain towns and villages in the counties of Hennepin, Wright, Carver and McLeod to aid in the construction of the Minneapolis and Northern Railroad;" be amended by striking out therefrom the word "Northern," and inserting instead thereof the word "Northwestern."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
