CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN CONVEYANCES HERETOFORE MADE AND PROCEEDINGS HAD THEREUNDER RELATING TO PARTNERSHIPS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all mortgages heretofore made of any real property in this State, or of any interest therein, to any partnership or firm, in their partnership or firm name, and which said mortgages have been foreclosed by advertisement pursuant to the statute relating to foreclosure by advertisement, in the name of said partnership or firm, be and the same are, together with all proceedings had in such foreclosure, hereby legalized and confirmed, so far as relates to any question of defect by reason of the mortgagees' names being stated in said mortgages by their partnership or firm name instead of the individual names of the members of said partnership or firm.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 141.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF ASSOCIATE JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME COURT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Number of judges.

Mortgages.

Section 1. The Supreme Court shall consist of one (1) Chief Justice and four (4) Associate Justices.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
