improvements as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this act; always provided, that all cell buildings hereinafter constructed shall be fire proof, and provided, that no money hereby appropriated shall be applied to the purchase of machinery, provided that no contract for construction or improvements shall be made in any one year in excess of the appropriation for such year, nor in advance of the actual requirements of the prison.

SEC. 2 That the Governor shall appoint a supervising architect, who shall hold office during the pleasure of the governor; that said supervising architect and the warden of the state prison and the board of inspectors of the state prison, shall constitute a board to be known as the building committee, the said warden of the state prison to be president of said committee, and said committee shall have full control and direction of the expenditure of the money hereby appropriated, and of the erection of any and all buildings, and the making of any and all improvements hereafter to be made with the money hereby appropriated.

How money to
be paid.

SEC. 3. The money hereby appropriated shall be paid upon the order of the secretary of the board hereby authorized to expend the same, countersigned by the warden of the state prison as president of said board.

SEC. 4. The compensation of said supervising architect shall be fixed by said building committee.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 167.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) TO WM. H. DUNGAN FOR TWO (2) MONTHS CLERICAL SERVICES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation

SECTION 1. That the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay Wm. H. Dungan for two (2) months clerical services in the department of public instruction.

SEC. 2 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
