

hereby authorized to appoint three (3) commissioners, whose duty it shall be to meet at such times and places as may be necessary and to immediately proceed to lay out a road as directed by the judge, in accordance with the prayer of the petition. *Provided*, that no road shall be ordered by any judge to extend more than six (6) miles outside the judicial district in which the application is made, and such road shall be extended beyond the district only for the purpose of commencing or ending at some public road."

SEC 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 22.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIXTY-ONE (61), TITLE THREE (3), CHAPTER SIXTY-FOUR (64), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNERED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), IN RELATION TO THE TIME OF HOLDING COURTS IN MARTIN COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section sixty-one (61), of title three (3), chapter sixty-four (64), of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be amended as follows:

Strike out the following:

"In the county of Martin on the fourth (4th) Tuesday of January."

And insert in lieu thereof the following words:

"In the county of Martin on the second (2d) Tuesday of September in each and every year."

SEC. 2. All laws inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
