

CHAPTER 23.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FOURTEEN (14), OF CHAPTER THIRTY-NINE (39), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO FRAUDULENT SALE OF MORTGAGED PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section fourteen (14) of chapter thirty-nine (39) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be amended by adding thereto the following proviso:

When sale prima facie fraudulent.

Provided that the fact of sale without the written consent of the mortgagee or assignee being established on the trial shall be prima facie evidence of a fraudulent intent on the part of the vendor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBDIVISION SECOND OF SECTION SIX (6), OF CHAPTER EIGHTY-ONE (81), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO THE FORECLOSURE OF MORTGAGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That subdivision second of section six (6), of chapter eighty-one (81), of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be, and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

Amendment.

"Second—The date of the mortgage and when (and where) recorded."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
