## CHAPTER 40.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1), OF CHAPTER SIXTY-ONE (61) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE EXTRA SESSION OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), RELATING TO HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section one (1) of chapter sixty-one (61) of the general laws of the extra-session of one thousand eight hundred and eighty one (1881), be amended to read as follows:

The high school board shall have full discretionary power to consider and act upon applications of schools for state aid and to prescribe the conditions upon which said aid shall be granted, and it shall be its duty to accept and aid such schools only as will, in its opinion, if aided, efficiently perform the service contemplated by law, but not more than five (5) schools shall be aided in each county in any one (1) Any school once accepted and continuing to comply with the law and regulations of the board made in pursuance thereof, shall be aided not less than three (3) years.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION NINETY (90), OF TITLE FOUR (4), OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF MINNESOTA, BEING SECTION TWO HUN-DRED AND THIRTY-ONE (231), OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34), OF GENERAL STATUTES ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUN-DRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER EIGHTEEN (18) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), EXTRA SESSION, RELATING TO RELIGIOUS COR-PORATIONS.
