

CHAPTER 7.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FIVE (5) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO PRINTING AND DISTRIBUTION OF LAWS AND DOCUMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter five (5) of the general statutes of the State of Minnesota of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, as follows:

SEC. 59. The secretary of state shall prepare a statement showing the times and places of holding the terms of the district courts in the several counties, and in such statement refer to the laws fixing the times for holding the same respectively: such statement shall be published with the laws for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883); and he shall thereafter, at the close of each legislative session, correct such statement, and publish the same, so corrected, with the general laws of the then next previous session.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage,

CHAPTER 8.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER SEVENTY-TWO (72) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), RELATING TO THE STATE HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Sections one (1) and two (2) of chapter seventy-two (72) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one (1881) relating to the state horticultural society shall be amended so as to read as follows.

SEC. 1. There shall be annually printed and bound thirty-five hundred (3,500) copies of the annual report
