CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE AND CONFIRM CONVEYANCES MADE TO AND BY CORPORATIONS IN CERTAIN CASES, AND TO RESTRICT THE SAME FROM THE OPERATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION TWO HUNDRED AND NINETY-FOUR (294), OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That the provisions of section two hundred and ninety-four (294), of chapter thirty-four (34), of the in relation to general statutes of this state, shall not apply to any conveyance heretofore made to or by, or hereafter made by any foreign corporation, created and organized with power under its charter to acquire, hold and convey real property in a fiduciary capacity.

SEC. 2. This act shall not apply to any action or proceeding heretofore brought and now pending to determine

the validity of any such conveyance.

This act shall take effect and be in force from SEC. 3. and after its passage.
