CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO BUILD A BRIDGE IN LINCOLN COUNTY, ACROSS YELLOW MEDICINE RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200), or so much thereof as may be necessary, out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund or out of the first (1st) money in the state treasury coming into such fund not already appropriated, to aid the county of Lincoln in building a bridge across the Yellow Medicine river, at or near Alta Vista, in said county.

SEC. 2. Such money shall be expended by the county commissioners of said county or a majority of them, for the purpose specified, and they shall locate, contract for, and supervise the construction of such

bridge.

Sec. 3. Samuel McPhoil, Fred Meinzer and Henry Welch, of said Lincoln county, are hereby appointed a committee on part of the state to examine such bridge when completed, to audit all accounts connected with its construction, and make report thereof to the state auditor, and such report shall show to whom the pay for construction shall be due, and a majority of such committee shall have full authority to act.

SEC. 4. Upon receipt of such report, the state auditor shall draw his proper order upon the state treasurer for the amount due and in favor of the party designated by the report of the committee, and the state treasurer shall thereupon pay the same.

SEC. 5. Such bridge when built, shall forever be free from toll and

shall be kept in repair without further charge to the state.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
