

CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO BUILD A BRIDGE IN LYON COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That there be, and hereby is appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund not otherwise appropriated, or out of the first money that may come into such fund, the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300), or so much thereof as may be necessary to build a bridge across, improve and make passable the outlet of Goose Lake in the town of Clifton, Lyon county.

SEC. 2. H. Newhouse, Jacob Dillmon and George Ladenberg are hereby appointed and authorized as committee on part of the state, to locate, contract for and supervise the construction of such bridge and improvements, and when the same shall have been completed, shall render a report thereof to the State Auditor, showing the cost thereof and to whom compensation shall be due.

SEC. 3. Upon receipt of the report of said committee or a majority of them, the State Auditor shall forthwith draw his proper order upon the State Treasurer for the amount, and in favor of the parties shown by such report to be proper, and the State Treasurer shall forthwith pay the same upon presentation.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO BUILD A BRIDGE ACROSS SHAKOPEE CREEK, IN SWIFT COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500), or so much thereof as may be required, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first (1st) moneys that shall come into the state treasury belonging to said fund not otherwise appropriated, to build a good and substantial bridge across the Shakopee creek in
