

CHAPTER 202.

AN ACT TO AID IN BUILDING A BRIDGE ACROSS THE PELICAN RIVER IN THE COUNTY OF OTTER TAIL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund or out of the first moneys which shall come into the state treasury belonging to said fund, to aid in building a bridge across the Pelican river, in the county of Otter Tail, at a point where the state road crosses said river in the village of Pelican Rapids.

SEC. 2. That said bridge shall be built under the direction of the board of county commissioners of said county of Otter Tail, and no part of said appropriation shall be paid out of the state treasury until said bridge is completed and ready for travel.

SEC. 3. That Theo. Frazee, R. E. Lacy and J. P. Wallace, are hereby appointed a committee on the part of the state, to view said bridge when completed and make a report to the state auditor.

SEC. 4. That upon the report of said committee to the state auditor, he shall upon the demand of the county treasurer of said county of Otter Tail, draw his order in favor of said county treasurer, on the state treasurer for moneys belonging to said fund, not to exceed two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250), and the state treasurer shall pay over such moneys to the county treasurer of said county upon said order; and such money shall be disbursed by said county treasurer upon the order of said board of county commissioners in payment for said bridge.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
