CHAPTER 203.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO AID IN CONSTRUCTING A BRIDGE ACROSS RUM RIVER, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF SPENCER BROOK, ISANTI COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400), out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund or out of the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund, and not otherwise appropriated, to aid in the construction of a bridge and approaches thereto, across Rum River near section fifteen (15), in the township of Spencer Brook, in the county of Isanti.

SEC. 2. That the following named citizens are hereby appointed commissioners on behalf of the state, under whose supervision said bridge shall be built, to-wit: William King, John Patterson, F. Ellingswood, E. W. Erickson and Wm. Tubbs.

SEC. 3. That the money hereby appropriated shall be paid out of the state treasury, to the treasurer of Isanti county, when the bridge is completed, and upon the state treasurer receiving a certified report of the completion and acceptance of said bridge, signed by said commissioners or a majority of them, and countersigned by the auditor of said Isanti county; and the said county treasurer shall, upon receipt of said money, make the proper disbursement under direction of said commissioners or a majority of them.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 204

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE ACROSS THE TWELVE (12) MILE CREEK IN THE TOWN OF RED PATH, COUNTY OF TRAVERSE, MINNESOTA, AND TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO AID IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF SAID BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Charles A. Smith, Hugh Spruce, Jr., and Charles Pullman are hereby appointed commissioners on the part of the state,
