upon the said order of the said board of county commissioners in payment for the cost and expenses of said bridges and repairs.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.

CHAPTER 207.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEYS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE OVER CROW RIVER, IN THE TOWN OF COKATO, WRIGHT COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund or out of the first moneys which shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund not already appropriated. to aid the town of Cokato, in the county of Wright, to build a wagon bridge over Crow river, on the section line between sections ten (10) and (11), township one hundred and eighteen (118), range twentyeight (28), in said town of Cokato.

Sec. 2. The moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid to the treasurer of said town of Cokato, upon the warrant of the state auditor, which warrant shall be issued upon the application of the board of supervisors of the said town of Cokato.

Said moneys so appropriated shall be expended under the direction of and by the board of supervisors aforesaid for the purpose of building the bridge aforesaid and for no other purpose whatever.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its SEC. 4.

passage.
