# CHAPTER 254.

#### AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LOWERING OF THE OUTLET OF DEAD LAKE, IN OTTER TAIL COUNTY.

#### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Those citizens in Otter Tail county in this state owning lands bordering or abutting upon Dead Lake, in said county, are hereby authorized and empowered to lower the outlet of said lake not to exceed three (3) feet. *Provided*, That all persons affected by such drainages consent thereto, and file such consent in writing, in the office of the register of deeds in and for said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage. Approved February 24, 1883.

## AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS TO REIMBURSE THE PERSON THEREIN MENTIONED FOR MONEYS ADVANCED FOR THE BENEFIT OF SAID CITY.

### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Minneapolis is hereby authorized and empowered to reimburse H. T. Welles, or other holder of a certain note for ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), by paying to said H. T. Welles, or to such other holder, out of any fund or funds of said city not otherwise appropriated, such sum, not exceeding ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), principal, as he, the said Welles, by cashing said note, advanced for the benefit of said city, under, pursuant to and upon the faith of the resolution of said city council, passed January fourth (4th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two (1882), and approved January sixteenth (16th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two (1882); and also by so paying interest upon the sum so advanced to the time of such reimbursement, at the rate in said note specified.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
