CHAPTER 262.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NICOLLET COUNTY, TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY TREASURER IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Whenever the county commissioners of Nicollet county, in the state of Minnesota, shall have directed and authorized the county treasurer of said county, to visit certain towns in said county, for the purpose of collecting taxes, the said board of commissioners are hereby authorized to allow said treasurer such reasonable compensation, for his extra expenses and clerk hire as they shall deem just, not to exceed the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200), in any one (1) year.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.

CHAPTER 263.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AND EMPOWER THE ANCIENT ORDER OF HIBERNIANS, OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, TO BECOME INCORPORATED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota

SECTION 1. That any state board now, or hereafter organized or existing in this state, under the authority of the national officers and national directory of the Ancient Order of Hibernians, of the United States of America, or any division of said Order in this state, now or hereafter organized or existing under authority of said national officers and directory, or under authority of said state board of said Order, may become incorporated in the manner following, to-wit:

Sec. 2. Such state board or each such division of said Order shall

cause to be prepared, a certificate which shall contain:

First—The charter name of such board or of such division and the

number thereof.

Second—The time when, and the authority under which said board or said division was organized.
