

CHAPTER 33.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "A BILL TO INCORPORATE THE MOUNT ZION HEBREW ASSOCIATION," APPROVED FEBRUARY TWENTY-SIXTH (26TH) ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SEVEN (1857).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. An act entitled "A bill to incorporate the Mount Zion Hebrew Association, approved February twenty-sixth (26th), one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven (1857), and which was amended by an act approved February twenty-ninth (29th) one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two (1872), is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

The said corporation is authorized and empowered to make a loan not exceeding five thousand dollars (\$5,000) and such time and rate of interest as shall be deemed advisable, and to mortgage the property of the said corporation as security therefor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THREE (3) OF CHAPTER FIVE (5) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX (1876), BEING AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF WYKOFF, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-NINE (139) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE (1875), AND CONFER CERTAIN POWERS UPON THE COUNCIL OF SAID VILLAGE THE ELECTORS THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three (3) of chapter five (5) of the Special Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six (1876), be and the same is hereby amended by annexing at the end of said section the following words, to-wit: "And the council of said village shall have power to construct sidewalks in said village as provided in said chapter one hundred and thirty-nine (139) of the General Laws
