

case, upon a petition being presented to him by four hundred (400) voters for that purpose, the auditor of said county be and hereby is authorized and required to call a special election of the legal voters of said county, to be held within thirty (30) days from the presentation of such petition, at a time to be mentioned and designated by such auditor and shall give the same notice of such election to the several town clerks of said county, that he is required to give by section seven (7) of this act, and said town clerks are hereby authorized and required upon receiving such notice to have duly called in their respective towns a special election for the purposes contemplated in this act. At such special election, said proposition to issue bonds shall be submitted, passed upon and determined as provided for by sections one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5) and six (6), in this act, and with the same force and effect as if the same had been duly determined at a general election as hereinbefore provided for.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 87.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THREE (3), OF CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND THIRTY (230), OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX (1876), CHANGING THE NUMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ST. CROIX BOOM CORPORATION FROM FIVE (5) TO NINE (9), AND TO FIX THE RATE OF BOOM-AGE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section three (3), of chapter two hundred and thirty (230), of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six (1876), be and hereby is amended by striking out the word "five" (5) contained in the second line of said section three (3), and insert in lieu thereof the word "nine" (9).

SEC. 2. The rate of boomage as fixed by chapter forty-five (45), of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), shall continue to be the rate which said boom corporation is authorized to collect until the same be changed by law.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
