

CHAPTER 139.

AN ACT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW JUDICIAL DISTRICT, TO BE KNOWN AS THE THIRTEENTH (13TH) JUDICIAL DISTRICT, AND TO FIX DATES FOR HOLDING COURT THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the counties of Jackson, Nobles, Rock, Pipe Stone, Murray, and Cottonwood be and the same are hereby detached from the sixth (6th) judicial district, and are hereby created into a judicial district, to be known and designated the thirteenth (13th) judicial district of Minnesota. Thirteenth judicial district.

SEC. 2. The terms of courts in said district to be held as follows: Terms of court, when held.

In Cottonwood county, the first (1st) Tuesday after July Fourth (4th) and the first (1st) Tuesday in January of each year.

In Jackson county, the first (1st) Tuesday of June and December of each year.

In Murray county, the third (3d) Tuesday in April and October of each year.

In Nobles county, the first (1st) Tuesday in March and November of each year.

In Pipe Stone county, the third (3d) Tuesday in May and December of each year.

In Rock county, the third (3d) Tuesday in March and September of each year.

SEC. 3. A district judge shall be elected therefor at the next general election, and the governor is hereby authorized to appoint a district judge for said district, to serve until his successor be elected. Appointment and election of judge of district.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
