

CHAPTER 180.

AN ACT RELATING TO MILLERS' AND MANUFACTURERS' MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. Whenever the capital of any company heretofore or hereafter organized under the provisions of chapter ninety-one(91) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one (1881) of the state of Minnesota, shall amount to the sum of two hundred thousand (200,000) dollars, of which amount not less than forty thousand (40,000) dollars shall be actual funds, as defined in said act, such company may assume risks on the all cash plan and issue policies against loss or damage by fire or lightning on any property, real or personal, to an amount not exceeding five (5) per centum of its capital, and on making to the insurance commissioner proof of such amount of capital shall be entitled to receive from him a certificate stating that it is entitled to assume risks and carry policies as herein provided.

When risks may be assumed on the cash plan.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

CHAPTER 181.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROPER INDEXING OF ALL RECORDS IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF DISTRICT COURT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the clerk of the district court of every county in this state to procure at the expense of the county two (2) well bound books to be denominated plaintiffs' index to court records, and defendants' index to court records, to be ruled and printed substantially in the following manner:

What to contain.

In which all the cases shall be entered in alphabetical order by the name of each plaintiff and defendant; said book shall set forth the names of the parties, kind of action, term commenced, the record, books and pages on which cases are recorded, the term disposed of, date of judgment, books and pages of the judgment dockets, execution dockets, fee books, satisfied or not satisfied, and number of case. The defendants' index shall be ruled and printed in the same manner as the plaintiffs', except the parties shall be reversed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 182.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND TOWN SUPERVISORS TO OFFER BOUNTIES FOR KILLING BLACKBIRDS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Authorized to offer a bounty for killing blackbirds.

SECTION 1. That the county commissioners of any county in the state, and the supervisors of any town in the state, are hereby authorized and empowered to offer a bounty for the killing of blackbirds, and they shall have power to provide such rules and regulations for the payment of such bounty as they may deem necessary.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
