

CHAPTER 274.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE THE EMPLOYES OF THE STATES PRISON FOR LOSSES BY THEM SUSTAINED FROM FIRE AT SAID STATES PRISON.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation
to reimburse
certain persons.

SECTION 1. That the sum of thirty-one hundred and fifteen (3,115) dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse the employes of the states prison for their losses at the recent fire, the names of said employes and the amount they are entitled to receive, are as follows: Abe Hall, two thousand (2,000) dollars; George Dodd, eight hundred (800) dollars; Frank H. Hall, thirty-five (35) dollars; Iowa Brown, one hundred and thirty (130) dollars; W. Wells, sixty (60) dollars; John E. Jelly, ninety (90) dollars.

SEC. 2. That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 275.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF MAKING CHANGES IN LAND CERTIFICATES TO SECURE A REDUCTION OF INTEREST ON STATE LANDS SOLD IN FORMER YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, for the purpose of paying expenses of the state land office in changing rate of interest in land contracts for lands sold in former years.
