CHAPTER 291.

AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF DANIEL RICE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

WHEREAS, It has been adjudged and decreed by the su- Preamble. preme court of the United States that the title to twelve hundred and forty (1240) acres of the land certified to said Daniel Rice by the governor of this state, and conveyed to him under and by virtue of an act of the legislature entitled "An act to provide for the location and construction of a state road" from Madelia in Watonwan county to a point on the western boundary of the state, approved March seventh (7th), A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixtytwo (1862), was never vested in said Daniel Rice by virtue of said conveyance or otherwise, but was at the time of said conveyance by the governor, and ever since has been, vested in the St. Paul & Sioux City Railroad Company; and

WHEREAS, Said Daniel Rice, relying upon the title so conveyed to him by the governor of Minnesota, paid the general taxes assessed upon said lands for five years after said conveyance, amounting in the aggregate, with interest at seven (7) per cent, to about the sum of six hundred (600) dollars; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated To refund cerout of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, six hundred (600) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to enable the state treasurer to refund to said Daniel Rice the money paid by him for taxes on said land, with interest from the date of the respective payments, at the rate of seven (7) per cent per annum.

State auditor to draw warrant for same.

SEC. 2. That within ninety (90) days after the passage of this act the state auditor shall, upon the presentation of all tax receipts and vouchers for money paid for taxes on said land by said Daniel Rice, state an account for the same and interest, as above provided, and draw his warrant upon the treasurer for the amount found due, not exceeding in the aggregate six hundred (600) dollars.

When act to take effect. SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 292.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR REPAIRS AND FUR-NISHING OF CAPITOL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Repairs of capitol. SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated, the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for deficiency of the appropriations for repairs and furnishing of the capitol, for the two (2) fiscal years ending July thirty-first (31st), A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885).

When act to take effect. SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) OUT OF ANY MONEYS IN THE STATE TREASURY NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED, TO PAY JAMES R. WALKER FOR SERVICES RENDERED IN QUARANTINING THE SMALL POX.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota: ,

For services rendered in quarantining. SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money
