CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FOUR (4) OF CHAPTER SIXTY-ONE (61) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO THE SOLEMNIZING OF MARRIAGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section four (4) of chapter sixty-one (61) of said statutes be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "record" in the third (3d) line of said section the following words: the superintendent of the department for the deaf and dumb in the Minnesota deaf, dumb and blind institute.

Who to perform ceremony.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 39.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR (124) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883), RELATING TO THE MAKING OF OFFICIAL REPORTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter one hundred and twenty-four (124) of the general laws of A. D. one thou-

sand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883) be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "the railroad commissioner" in the second (2d) line of said section, and inserting the same after the word "insurance" in the twenty-fourth (24th) line of the section.

CHAPTER 40.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1), CHAPTER SEVENTY (70), AND SECTION ONE (1), CHAPTER TWENTY-NINE (29), GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO GOVERNOR'S SALARY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Increase of salary.

SECTION 1. That section one (1), chapter seventy (70) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be amended by striking out in the first clause of said section the words "three thousand eight hundred" (3,800), and inserting in lieu thereof the words "five thousand" (5,000).

Change of salary.

SEC. 2. That section one (1), chapter twenty-nine (29) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be amended by striking out the words and figures in the first clause of said section after the word governor, "three thousand eight hundred (\$3,800)" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "five thousand."

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
