dred and seventy-eight (1878) be amended so as to read as follows:

Right of way granted.

Sec. 43. That a right of way is hereby granted over any swamp, school, internal improvement, agricultural college, or university lands held by the state, to any railroad company proposing to construct, or that has constructed a railroad over or upon the same on the conditions and terms herein provided.

Legalization of all deeds for right of way purposes. SEC. 2. That any and all deeds for right of way purposes over university lands heretofore made by the state to railroad companies are hereby legalized.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND SEVEN (107) OF CHAPTER SIXTY-FOUR (64) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO APPEALS FROM JUSTICES OF THE PEACE IN THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and seven (107) of chapter sixty-four (64), general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following, to-wit: "Except that the appellant shall cause to be served on the respondent or his attorney, a notice of trial, at least eight (8) days before the term at which said appeal is to be heard."

Serve notice of trial—time limited.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

When act to take effect. SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
