CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT DECLARING THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF STILL-WATER, WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, CREATED BY CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED (200) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX (1876), AND CON-TINUED BY CHAPTER NINETY-TWO (92) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), LEGALLY CREATED AND CONSTITUTED AND DEFINING ITS POWERS AND JURISDICTION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The municipal court of the city of Stillwater, Washington county, Minnesota, heretofore created by chapter two hundred (200) of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six (1876), and continued by chapter ninety-two(92) of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eightyone (1881), is hereby declared legally created and constituted, and shall be governed by and possess all the power and jurisdiction conferred upon it by said chapter ninety-two (92) of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881).

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
