

## CHAPTER 121.

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER NINETY-NINE (99) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE OF EXCELSIOR, IN THE COUNTY OF HENNEPIN, IN THIS STATE, TO ISSUE BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING THE STREETS OF SAID VILLAGE."

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter ninety-nine (99) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883) of this state be amended by adding to and at the end of said section one (1) the words "and to fund the debt of said village."

SEC. 2. That section four (4) of said chapter ninety-nine (99) be amended by inserting in the sixth (6th) line after the figures "1883" the words "or at any subsequent annual election, or at a special election called for acting upon this question."

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
