to be called the Minnesota river bridge tax, and said tax when collected shall not be used for any other purpose than that for which the same was collected.

SEC. 4. Said bonds shall not be negotiated at less than par.

SEC. 5. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 139.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY OF RAMSEY TO ISSUE BONDS IN THE AID OF THE ERECTION OF AN ALMSHOUSE, ON THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (1) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (1) OF SECTION NUMBER TWENTY-SEVEN (27), TOWNSHIP NUMBER TWENTY-NINE (29), RANGE NUMBER TWENTY-THREE (23).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the county of Ramsey is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and negotiate the bonds of the county of Ramsey for the amount and for the purpose hereinafter named: For the erection of an almshouse upon the northeast quarter $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the northeast quarter $(\frac{1}{2})$ of section number twenty-seven (27), township number twenty-nine (29), range number twenty three (23). To an amount not exceeding twenty-five thousand (25,000) dollars.

SEC. 2. Said bonds shall be of the denominations of one thousand (1,000) dollars each, with interest coupons attached, and shall be payable in thirty (30) years after their date, with interest at a rate not to exceed five (5) per cent per annum, payable semi-annually at the financial agency of the city of Saint Paul in the city of New York, and none of said bonds shall be negotiated or sold for less than par.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
