

## CHAPTER 173.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE JUDGE OF PROBATE OF MORRISON COUNTY TO EMPLOY A CLERK TO COMPLETE THE RECORDS IN HIS OFFICE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the judge of probate of Morrison county be, and he is hereby, authorized and empowered to employ a clerk to complete the records in his office up to the first (1st) day of January A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885).

SEC. 2. That such clerk shall receive as compensation for doing the writing authorized to be done by the foregoing section, fifteen (15) cents per folio of writing done by him in doing such work, to be paid out of the treasury of said county.

SEC. 3. That upon the completion of his said work to the satisfaction of said judge of probate, he shall report the same to the county commissioners of said county, who shall cause the amount of such work to be computed and paid for by said county, at the price above specified.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
