

## CHAPTER 196.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF STEARNS COUNTY TO ALLOW AND PAY BILLS INCURRED IN SMALL POX CASES IN ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881) AND ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO (1882).

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Stearns county are hereby authorized and directed to re-examine and adjust the claim of A. G. Jaques, and other persons of said county, for services rendered by him, or them, in the years of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881) and one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two (1882), in the treatment of persons inflicted with the small pox disease, and in carrying out the regulations adopted by the board of health of said county to prevent the spread of such disease, and all matters pertaining thereto, and to allow and pay said Jaques and others for all such services what the same was reasonably worth, notwithstanding said Jaques and others were, at the time of the rendition of such services, of the county commissioners of said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval.
