

CHAPTER 229.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE STATE ROAD RUNNING FROM HERMAN TO GRACEVILLE, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all the acts of the commissioners in laying out and establishing the state road from Herman, Grant county, Minnesota, to Graceville, Big Stone county, Minnesota, under and by virtue of chapter two hundred and forty-seven (247) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879), be and the same are hereby declared to be for all purposes whatsoever legal and valid, and the said road to be legally laid out and established.

SEC. 2. The county commissioners of the several counties through which said road passes are hereby authorized and empowered to file, or cause to be filed, in the office of the register of deeds of each of such counties, a plat of said road, where the same has not already been filed, for the information of the public.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 230.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF THE VOTERS OF THE VILLAGE OF JORDAN, IN SCOTT COUNTY, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF BONDS BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the action of the voters of the village of Jordan, in the county of Scott, in said state, in voting on the twenty-third (23d) day of August, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four (1884), that the bonds of said village be issued by the village council
