CHAPTER 242.

AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF THE PROBATE COURT OF HENNEPIN COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The compensation of the clerk of the probate court of the county of Hennepin shall be fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500) per annum, and three hundred dollars (\$300) per annum additional for clerk hire, and shall be paid monthly by the treasurer of the county of Hennepin, upon the warrant of the county auditor; *Provided*, That the county auditor shall not draw his warrant for such salary until such clerk has filed with such auditor a certificate, under the hand of the judge of probate, stating the exact time which such clerk has served as clerk of probate during the month for which such salary is due and payable by the terms of this act.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts relating to the compensation of clerks of probate courts are, so far as they relate to the compensation of the clerk of the probate court of Hennepin county, hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 243.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE COMPENSATION OF THE COUNTY SURVEY-OR OF WASHINGTON COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The county surveyor of the county of Washington shall be entitled to receive as compensation for his services for each day employed in the discharge of his duties as county surveyor, including the time necessarily spent in traveling to and from the field of
