## CHAPTER 274.

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FISHWAYS IN THE DAMS ACROSS TURTLE CREEK, IN THE COUNTIES OF FREEBORN AND MOWER, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the owner of any dam now built or that may be hereafter built across Turtle creek, in either Freeborn or Mower county, Minnesota, to cause to be constructed and maintained fishways of proper width and depth to allow all fish endeavoring to migrate to the waters of said creek above said dams to freely pass over the same. The said fishways shall be constructed under the direction of the fish commissioner of the state of Minnesota, who shall furnish plans for the same; and said fishways shall be located in such place and built in such manner and of such material as said commissioner shall direct. And it is hereby made the duty of said fish commissioner, when informed by letter or otherwise of the need of such fishway, to send plans to the owner of such dam, with directions to build the same.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
