with the ordinances of said village relating to the licensing of the sale of such liquors, and the druggist so licensed shall be exempt from the general laws of this state relating to the sale of such liquors; *Provided*, That the amount to be paid for such license shall not exceed the sum of twenty-five (25) dollars per year; *And provided further*, That no license shall be granted under this act to any person not dealing in a general line of drugs and medicines in said village; *And provided further*, That such license shall not permit such druggist to sell, barter or give away such liquors in a less quantity than one-half  $(\frac{1}{2})$  pint.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 309.

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT IN RELATION TO THE CITY OF MANKATO, PRESCRIBING THE MANNER OF TAKING PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR PUBLIC USE, AND LEVYING ASSESSMENTS THERE-FOR, AND FOR OTHER LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS," BEING CHAPTER ELEVEN (11), SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE (1873).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section three (3) of an act entitled "An act in relation to the city of Mankato, prescribing the manner of taking private property for public use and levying assessments therefor, and for other local improvements," be amended by striking out the second (2d) proviso in said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "Provided, also, That upon a vote of two-thirds ( $\hat{s}$ ) of the aldermen elect any improvement mentioned in the foregoing section (including that of the cost of laying out and constructing a system of general sewerage within said city) may be made by the city at large without special assessment."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
